STUDENT EXPECTATIONS ON THE BUS

Valley Center USD #262 Transportation Department

Every student will be transported in the safest possible manner. In order to ensure this, it is necessary for all students to meet behavior expectations and follow safe riding rules. Below are the CHAMPS rules for riding a school bus, parents are to help their children understand the importance of these rules as they relate to their personal safety. Remember the bus ride is an extension of the school day and that school and classroom conduct is expected at the bus stop as well as on the bus.

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|---------------------------|---|
| C onversation | Voice Level 1 or 2 – Whisper or quiet conversation |
| H elp | Raise your hand and ask the bus driver for help. |
| A ctivity | Be respectful to everyone in your words and actions. Be on time at the bus stop. Bring only school appropriate items on the bus. |
| M ovement | Stay seated in assigned seat unless otherwise directed. Exit and enter safely using handrails, walk, feet on floor, face forward, keep body parts and objects inside the bus. |
| P articipation | Follow directions (No food, drink or gum, backpacks in appropriate place) |
| S uccess in School | Safety for all riders, obey the driver and/or aide at all times. |

The use of Personal Electronic Devices such as cell phones and iPods is allowed on the bus when used quietly and appropriately. Students are personally responsible for the security of any Personal Electronic Devices.

Violation of the bus rules can result in suspension or revocation of the privilege to ride the bus.

The undersigned persons acknowledge receiving a copy of *Student Expectations on the Bus* and understand that a student's riding privilege may be suspended or revoked for unsafe and/or inappropriate conduct on the bus.
