

MEMO: Enrollment of Non-Resident Students

USD 262 Valley Center Schools policy JBC Enrollment states the following concerning Non-Resident Students:

Non-resident Students Non-resident students are those who do not meet the definition of a resident student. Although the district is not required to admit non-resident students, nonresident students may be admitted to the extent that staff, facilities, equipment, and supplies are available. Other criteria regarding students seeking non-resident student admittance may be considered prior to acting on any annual non-resident student application as specified in this policy.

Administrative Practices for Enrollment of Non-Resident Students

Criteria for Consideration of Priority Levels

1. A child living outside of district boundaries with a parent/guardian that is employed with USD 262 or Sedgwick County Special Education Cooperative (based on classroom availability and a student in good standing)
2. A child living outside of district boundaries that had enrolled and attended schools in Valley Center previously (based on classroom availability, Limited Out of District enrollment application complete on or before August 18th and a student found to be in good standing)
3. A child living outside of district boundaries with other members of the immediate family who currently attend schools in Valley Center {i.e. separated families} (based on classroom availability, Limited Out of District enrollment application complete on or before August 18th, and a student found to be in good standing).
4. A child living outside of district boundaries with a parent/guardian that can provide proof ownership of property (i.e. farmland, business ownership, etc.) within district boundaries.


